## Hardin FFA Show Team Rules

*(These rules are subject to change per Advisor's discretion)*

All shows (livestock, mechanics, horticulture, etc.) attended by Hardin FFA have specific rules, which must be followed. An exhibitor or their violation any rule may be given one verbal warning. The second violation may automatically result in disqualification from any show under the discretion of the Advisor.

### **All exhibitors must adhere to the following rules:**

1. Exhibitors will remember any show attended by Hardin FFA is a school activity. All rules pertaining to school activities will be adhered to. NO PASS NO PLAY, etc..
2. Students participating in any show with Hardin FFA must be signed in with an agriculture teacher at the grounds of the show by 8 A.M and must remain on the grounds until 3:30 P.M to be excused from school. Please remember livestock must be fed by 5:00 P.M unless the student or student's parents have an approved excuse by the agriculture teachers.
3. Exhibitors will not be allowed to leave the show grounds without permission from agriculture teachers.
4. Exhibitors must maintain their own SAE projects. The exhibitor may ask for assistance but remember it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to clean, groom, trim and present his/her project.
5. Exhibitors will be assigned stall duties throughout the livestock show as necessary. Keep unnecessary items (food, drink, clothes, etc.) out of view. Students must be present for stall duties or the student will face consequences an agriculture teacher deems appropriate.
6. Students will be the only persons to work stall duties. We ask that parents please do not work stalls. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor. Judges will not reward the chapter for stall award points if adults are seen working the cleanup and maintenance.
7. Exhibitors will not congregate in the tack area. The exhibit area is not the place for loud or disruptive behavior.
8. It is up to the exhibitors to secure their own transportation to and from the show for feedings during the day. Agriculture teachers are not always off from school to attend all day and miss school. If you need help please contact one of us.
9. Exhibitors will exhibit sportsmanship expected of them as members of the FFA.
19. All HISD policies will be followed at all times. Parents and volunteers must adhere to all HISD guidelines while attending or supervising students. Failure to do so may result in the individual being restricted to HISD/FFA activities.

**2021 JUNIOR SHOW ENTRY CERTIFICATION RULES**

By signing the entry form:

The undersigned Exhibitor and his/her Parent or Legal Guardian, County Extension Agent ("CEA") or Agricultural Science Teacher ("AST") hereby certify that each has read, understands and agrees to be bound by all of the provisions of the 2021 San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo Livestock Premium List and all rules and regulations of the San Antonio Livestock Exposition, Inc. ("S.A.L.E."). We further certify that we have not administered and, to the best of our knowledge, any entry from this exhibitor has not been unethically fitted and has not received any substance not approved by the FDA and/or USDA. In instances where an animal has been administered a drug that is FDA-approved for its species, the exhibitor must be aware that the time it takes for all drug residue to completely clear the system is **generally longer than the labeled withdrawal time** for most drugs and varies from animal to animal. Adequate time must have passed so that an exhibitor's animal does not test positive for drugs upon arrival. Once the animals arrive on the S.A.L.E. grounds, they must remain free and clear of all residues of medications, drugs, chemicals, and other substances.

**Veterinarians / Medication:** Those animals that have consumed or been given, even under the care of a licensed veterinarian, any type of performance enhancing medication, drug, chemical, or substance, including but not limited to steroids, diuretics, anti-inflammatories, tranquilizers and pain killers, are **ineligible for competition**. All drugs and medication administered during the livestock show must be administered by the Official S.A.L.E. Veterinarian and a written medication record must be filed. Animals receiving performance enhancing drugs (e.g., steroids, diuretics, anti-inflammatories, tranquilizers and painkillers, etc.) in this manner are ineligible for competition. As breeding animals are not entering the food chain, the USDA Wholesome Meat Act does not apply; however, breeding animals will be closely screened for any performance enhancing compounds. This includes, but is not limited to, steroids, diuretics, anti-inflammatories, tranquilizers and painkillers.

S.A.L.E. will not tolerate the presence of ractopamine hydrochloride (Optaflexx™; Paylean®) in market entries other than market steers or market barrows, respectively. S.A.L.E. will not tolerate the presence of ractopamine hydrochloride (Topmax™) in Market Poultry, specifically all turkeys and broilers. S.A.L.E. will not tolerate the presence of zilpaterol hydrochloride (Zimmax®) in any market species or breeding animal.

Exhibitor and his or her parents agree that any animal entered by him or her may be subjected to inspection, examination, or testing by any veterinarian appointed by S.A.L.E. and that S.A.L.E. may conduct or take any tests, examinations, samples, and inspections that S.A.L.E. deems necessary or appropriate, including but not limited to tests for drugs or other substances, at any time. S.A.L.E. shall have the right to conduct or have conducted for it all tests, inspections, or analyses it deems appropriate or necessary, including but not limited to ultrasound, D.N.A., blood, tissue, and urine laboratory analysis, on any animal entered in or exhibited at the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo. The exhibitor (and, for Junior exhibitors, the exhibitor's parent, legal guardian, or AST or CEA) must be present during the collection of an initial urine sample for testing and must witness, seal and sign the sample, thereby establishing that the sample was properly collected and prepared for analysis. Subsequent samples of any sort may be taken by or for S.A.L.E. without the presence of the exhibitor or his or her parent, legal guardian, or AST or CEA. All decisions based on any test, inspection, analysis, or examination conducted by or for S.A.L.E. shall be final and conclusive and no exhibitor shall have any recourse against S.A.L.E. or any of its officers, directors, volunteers, or employees, or any veterinarian appointed by S.A.L.E., for any such decision.

Exhibitor and his or her parents agree that each of them waives and releases S.A.L.E. and each of its agents, employees, volunteers, members, veterinarians, and contractors from any and all claims, causes of action, liabilities, and demands of every sort based on, arising out of, or relating to the inspection or testing of any such animal and any ruling, decision, or action taken as a result of or in reliance on the results of any test or inspection, whether or not such testing or inspection was conducted in compliance with these rules. The foregoing waiver and release applies to any causes of action, claims, and demands based on the actual or alleged negligence or gross negligence of S.A.L.E. or any of its veterinarians, employees, and volunteers. Exhibitor and his or her parents also agree to indemnify and hold S.A.L.E. harmless from and against all claims, suits, causes of action, liabilities, damages, demands, costs, expenses (including attorneys' fees), and other losses (together, "Claims") asserted against or incurred by S.A.L.E. based on, arising from, or in any way relating to any act or omission by S.A.L.E. or the use or condition of any real or personal property at or in connection with the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo, including, without limitation, all Claims based on, arising out of, or relating to any negligent act or omission of or by S.A.L.E.

In the event any animal is determined to be unethically fitted, Exhibitor will forfeit all titles, awards, prizes, auction proceeds, premiums, scholarships and market/floor money. Further, the Executive Director & CEO is authorized to permanently bar the Exhibitor and his/her family from any further participation in any S.A.L.E. events. Reinstatement of anyone barred may be made only by the Executive Director & CEO.

All claims or disputes between Exhibitor (and his/her parent or guardian, CEA, and AST) and S.A.L.E. (including each of its agents, employees, volunteers, members, veterinarians, and contractors) in any way arising out of or related to Exhibitor's entry and participation in the San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo that are not subject to final resolution by S.A.L.E. pursuant to its rules and this entry form shall be decided by binding arbitration administered by the American Arbitration Association ("AAA") and in accordance with the Commercial Arbitration Rules of the AAA that are in effect at the time the demand for arbitration is filed, unless the parties mutually agree otherwise in writing. The decision of the arbitrator(s) shall be final, conclusive and binding on the parties and judgment may be entered thereon by a court of competent jurisdiction to enforce the decision. Jurisdiction and venue for any dispute regarding this Agreement shall lie solely and exclusively in Bexar County, Texas.

The Exhibitor and his/her Parent or Legal Guardian, CEA or AST understand and agree to the Civil Authority Evacuation Statement as well as the COVID 19, Liability and Release and Indemnity Rules (General Rules, Sections 6 & 7) as stated in the General Rules of the Livestock Premium List.

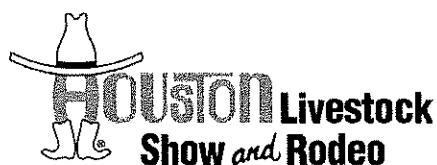

#### Tractor Unloading/Loading

- The San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo assumes no responsibility for damage or accidents occurring during the driving, unloading and loading processes. It is imperative that the AST/CEA/driver are familiar with the equipment so the process can be performed in a safe and efficient manner. The person driving/unloading/loading the tractor on behalf of the club/chapter is to be designated by the AST/CEA. Show officials will expect the person performing these duties has been approved by the AST/CEA.
- The following is a list of procedures for tractor unloading/loading:
  - The driver must be familiar with operating the tractor as well as the trailer it is loaded onto and have practiced loading/unloading prior to the show.
  - The tractor should have an operating throttle (must throttle down to an idle), clutch, and brakes (both right and left are equal in pressure to engage).
  - Show officials may check tractor operating controls, including brakes to determine if they function properly when locked together prior to allowing the tractor to be unloaded/loaded. Tractor must be able to start and be throttled to idle smoothly.
  - Tires should be monitored; rear tire pressure should not exceed 10 psi. Prior to unloading/loading tires should not be treated with tire black, especially the tread. Exercise caution if unloading/loading in wet or windy conditions.
  - Other projects/equipment should not be loaded on the rear of the trailer to prevent unloading or loading of the tractor. If a project is loaded on rear of the trailer, it must be pulled to the project offloading area near the barns to be unloaded, then the trailer will be pulled back in to the tractor unloading area. Fork lifts will not be brought to the trailer to unload or load projects in the tractor unloading/loading area.
  - If the tractor is a tricycle type (one or a narrow front wheel(s)) then the trailer must be equipped with a middle ramp that is hinged to the trailer securely or ramp should extend across total width of the trailer.
  - All ramps on trailer must be designed with proper traction; this is especially important in wet weather conditions.
  - Trailers hauling crawler (track) type tractors must be equipped with suitable ramps.
  - The driver will be given instructions by the show officials on where to unload/load the tractor. Area will be marked/designated.
  - Show officials will perform a cursory check of the tires and operating controls after unloading.
  - It is the responsibility of the driver to ensure that the area around the trailer and unloading area is clear and safe prior to unloading/loading.
  - If show officials, at any time, are concerned with safety of unloading/loading, they may halt the process and direct the driver to an alternate site to wait until additional equipment can be used to augment the unloading process.
- No more than 10 gallons of fuel in the fuel tank
- Neat and functional drip pans (required only at night) containing floor absorbent material (cat litter) to collect any coolant, oil, or hydraulics that may drip from the tractor should be placed under tractor when tractor is not being judged. Drip pan should not be used during day when tractor is being judged.
- Fuel shut off valves, under all fuel tanks, must be functional and all tractors must be exhibited with these valves off. Fuel caps do not need to be taped.

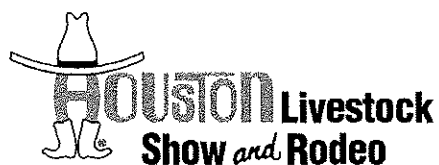

**3. RELEASE FROM LIABILITY:** The undersigned hereby RELEASE, ACQUIT AND FOREVER DISCHARGE HLSR, its subsidiaries and affiliates and its and their present and former directors, officers, employees, agents, volunteers, and representatives and the respective heirs, administrators, executors, successors and assigns (collectively, the "HLSR Parties" or individually, an "HLSR Party") from any and all claims, causes of action, suits, demands, settlements, judgments and/or expenses (including, but not limited to, reasonable attorneys' fees) for personal injury, death and/or property damage, accrued or to accrue in the future, known or unknown, (collectively, "Claims") relating to or arising out of any negligent acts in connection with his/her entry into and participation in the Activities, including but not limited to the **NEGLIGENT ACTIONS OF THE HLSR PARTIES, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER SUCH NEGLIGENCE WAS THE SOLE, PROXIMATE OR PRODUCING CAUSE OF THE CLAIMS**. An Exhibitor may choose a licensed veterinarian other than the Official Show Veterinarian, but the Official Show Veterinarian MUST be notified in advance and he/she MUST be present. All treatment costs are the responsibility of the Exhibitor. If an animal is treated by a licensed veterinarian while at the Show and the medication administered contains a labeled withdrawal time or unpublished elimination time, the animal will be disqualified. Sifted and non-placing barrows, lambs and goats will be sold as condemned if the animal is under any withdrawal requirement. The Official Show Veterinarian, in agreement with Show Management, reserves the right to treat any animal if, in the opinion of the Official Show Veterinarian, it is in the best interest of the animal's health and well-being to be treated. If the Official Show Veterinarian administers treatment to an animal and therefore uses any medication that does not meet the appropriate withdrawal or elimination time, the animal will be determined ineligible for competition.

The Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo reserves the right to condemn and/or disqualify any animal, either live or slaughtered, found in violation of the use of drugs, chemicals or feed additives as described above and the exhibitor will forfeit all auction sale and/or premium money if the animal is disqualified. If an animal(s) is disqualified for testing positive and/or the carcass condemned at slaughter, the class placing will not change. An exhibitor of an animal testing positive for any drug or medication or unapproved chemical may forfeit all rights and privileges to exhibit livestock in the future at the Show. Furthermore, any infraction resulting in disqualification may affect Exhibitor's scholarship eligibility.

The undersigned fully understand and grant permission to HLSR to report any and all rule infractions to the North American Livestock Show and Rodeo Managers Association (NALS/RMA) Rule Infraction Database (RID). Furthermore, we understand that this information will be available to the membership of the NALS/RMA.

## RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

In consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, for being allowed entry into and participation in activities (the "Activities") associated with Rodeo Austin, hereinafter "RODEO AUSTIN", the undersigned hereby enters into this RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT (this "Agreement") as of the date set forth below.

1. **ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RISKS:** The undersigned recognizes and understands that there are risks associated with their participation in the Activities including, but not limited to, bodily injury or death to persons and damage to property. The undersigned further acknowledges and understands that they will be held liable and responsible for any and all damage to persons, livestock, vehicles, property and/or improvements to property that is caused by them and/or any persons (including, but not limited to, minors) under their care and control, and that arise out of, or are related to, the undersigned's entry into and participation in the Activities.

2. **APPLICABILITY AND SCOPE OF RELEASES AND INDEMNITIES:** For purposes of this Agreement, "Claims" shall mean any past, present and future claims, losses, costs, expenses, liabilities, demands, or causes of action, and costs of defense or settlement (including, without limitation, attorneys' fees and court costs). For purposes of this Agreement, the term "Released Parties" shall mean RODEO AUSTIN, the City of Austin, Texas, Travis County, State of Texas and their respective present and former officers, directors, members, council members, commissioners, subsidiaries, affiliates, employees, staff, volunteers, agents and any other person, firm, corporation or entity bound to defend or pay judgments against them. The releases, waivers and indemnities contained in this Agreement expressly shall apply regardless of whether the Claims to be released, waived or indemnified against arise, or are alleged to arise, from (i) **NEGLIGENCE (WHETHER SOLE, JOINT OR CONCURRENT), GROSS NEGLIGENCE, NEGLIGENCE PER SE, and/or STRICT LIABILITY**, of the Released Parties; (ii) personal injury, death or property damage; (iii) acts under the Texas Deceptive Trade Practices Act ("DTPA"); (iv) acts of any other persons or guests; (v) theft, burglary, assault, or other crimes; (vi) fire, water, wind, rain and/or smoke and/or (vii) any other risks and hazards associated with the undersigned's entry into and participation in the Activities, including, but not limited to, the general conditions at the Activities, animals both wild and domestic that may be diseased and/or potentially dangerous, persons with firearms both on and off the premises used in connection with the Activities, and the driving or riding in any vehicles, whether belonging to Released Parties or to other persons.

3. **RELEASE FROM LIABILITY:** The undersigned hereby releases, acquiesces and forever discharges any and all Claims against any of the Released Parties that arise from or relate to their entry and participation in the Activities—including, but not limited to, the types of claims enumerated in Paragraph 2—and agree not to sue any of the Released Parties for such Claims. Without limiting the foregoing, the undersigned agrees that the Released Parties shall not be liable to them, their family, agents, employees or their guests, for personal injury, property damage, or any other Claims arising from or related to the undersigned's entry into and participation in the Activities.

4. **AGREEMENT TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS:** The undersigned agrees to INDEMNIFY and HOLD HARMLESS the Released Parties against any and all Claims arising from or related to the undersigned's entry and participation in the Activities—including, but not limited to, the types of Claims enumerated in Paragraph 2. In addition, and without limiting the foregoing, the undersigned agrees to INDEMNIFY the Released Parties for any Claims for injuries to any minors under their care and control and/or his or her parent/guardian, and for any Claims asserted by, through or under the undersigned, arising from or related to the undersigned's entry into and participation in the Activities—including, but not limited to, the types of Claims enumerated in Paragraph 2. As used herein, "INDEMNIFY" means to agree to assume the Released Parties' liability in a situation, thereby relieving them of responsibility, and/or reimbursing the Released Party for Claims asserted against them.

5. **COVID-19:** Because COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is spread mainly from person-to-person contact, Rodeo Austin has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19. However, Rodeo Austin cannot guarantee that its participants, exhibitors, volunteers, partners or others in attendance will not become infected with COVID-19. In light of the ongoing spread of COVID-19, individuals who fall within any of the categories below should not engage in Rodeo Austin events. By attending a Rodeo Austin event, you certify that you do not fall into any of the following categories:

- i. Individuals who currently or within the past fourteen (14) days have experienced any symptoms associated with COVID-19, which include fever, cough and shortness of breath among others
- ii. Individuals who believe that they may have been exposed to a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19 or have been diagnosed with COVID-19 and are not yet cleared as non-contagious by state or local public health authorities or the health care team responsible for their treatment

**DUTY TO SELF-MONITOR:** Participants agree to self-monitor for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 (symptoms typically include fever, cough, and shortness of breath) and contact Rodeo Austin if he/she experiences symptoms of COVID-19 within 14 days after participating at Rodeo Austin.

**ASSUMPTION OF THE RISK:** I acknowledge and understand the following:

- i. Participation includes possible exposure to and illness from infectious diseases including but not limited to COVID-19. While particular rules and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious illness and death does exist
- ii. I knowingly and freely assume all such risks related to illness and infectious diseases, such as COVID-19, even if arising from the negligence or fault of the Released Parties
- iii. I hereby knowingly assume the risk of injury, harm and loss associated with the Activity, including any injury, harm and loss caused by the negligence, fault or conduct of any kind on the part of the Released Parties.

6. **PHOTOGRAPH/INTERVIEW RELEASE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT:** The undersigned grants permission to be photographed, videoed or interviewed in connection with the Activities. The undersigned understands that any such photograph, video or interview may be used by the Released Parties or television, film, video, visual, graphic or printed media. The undersigned agrees to RELEASE and INDEMNIFY the Released Parties with respect to any Claims related to the usage of such photographs or interviews by the Released Parties or any media—including, but not limited to, the types of Claims enumerated in Paragraph 2.

7. **CRIMINAL HISTORY AND BACKGROUND CHECK AUTHORIZATION:** In furtherance of RODEO AUSTIN's commitment to protecting the security, safety, and health of its patrons, invitees, participants, vendors, contractors, employees, staff and volunteers, and maintaining a wholesome and safe family atmosphere for its events, RODEO AUSTIN has adopted a policy requiring members and volunteers to authorize RODEO AUSTIN to perform criminal history and background checks in accordance with RODEO AUSTIN's Criminal Background Check Policy. As further inducement for RODEO AUSTIN to permit the Participant's entry into and participation in the Activities, the undersigned certifies that Participant has never been convicted or received deferred adjudication of: (1) any crime involving the sexual abuse of children; (2) any crime against a minor; (3) any felony relating to violence, assaultive conduct, or sexual offense; (4) any other felony (other than sex or violence related) within the past ten years; or (5) any offense relating to the operation of an amusement ride. If Participant has been convicted or adjudicated of any such crime, Participant may disclose such information to the Chief Operating Officer of RODEO AUSTIN and seek an exemption to allow the Participant to volunteer for the Activities on the RODEO AUSTIN Grounds and offsite events as authorized by RODEO AUSTIN's Criminal Background Check Policy. The undersigned, on behalf of Participant, further authorizes RODEO AUSTIN to perform a criminal history and background check on Participant to verify the representations made above and continued compliance with RODEO AUSTIN's Criminal Background Check Policy. The undersigned, on behalf of Participant, further authorizes RODEO AUSTIN to review any sex offender registries under Participant's name. The undersigned, on behalf of Participant, agrees to provide all other necessary authorizations for

RODEO AUSTIN representatives to secure and review the results of such criminal history and background checks. The undersigned, on behalf of Participant, agrees that if Participant is charged with such a crime, that the undersigned will immediately self-disclose, advise and notify RODEO AUSTIN.

8. **CONFIDENTIALITY:** Participant acknowledges that during his/her participation in the Activities that Participant may have access to, receive or become acquainted with certain non-public and confidential information, including but not limited to various trade secrets, inventions, innovations, processes, information, records, membership lists, donor lists, contracts, and specifications owned or licensed by RODEO AUSTIN and/or used by RODEO AUSTIN in connection with the Activities and the operation of RODEO AUSTIN. All such non-public and confidential information is hereinafter called the "Confidential Information" and shall remain the property of RODEO AUSTIN at all times. Participant will keep RODEO AUSTIN's Confidential Information confidential from all third parties. Participant shall not disclose any of the aforesaid Confidential Information, directly or indirectly, or use any of it in any manner, either during the term of this Agreement or at any time thereafter, except as required in the course and scope of Participant's participation in the Activities. Participant acknowledges that the Confidential Information is unique and valuable, and that breach of the obligations of this Agreement regarding such Confidential Information will result in irreparable injury to RODEO AUSTIN for which monetary damages alone would not be an adequate remedy. Therefore, Participant agrees that in the event of a breach or threatened breach of such provisions, RODEO AUSTIN shall be entitled to injunctive or other equitable relief as a remedy for any such breach or anticipated breach without the necessity of posting a bond. Any such relief shall be in addition to and not in lieu of any appropriate relief in the way of monetary damages. All Confidential Information shall be and remain the property of RODEO AUSTIN, and Participant shall return all of such Confidential Information to RODEO AUSTIN upon the earlier of the termination of this Agreement or Participant's termination as a member/volunteer of RODEO AUSTIN.

9. **COMPLETE AND FINAL RELEASE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT:** As further inducement to RODEO AUSTIN to permit the undersigned's entry into and participation in the Activities, the undersigned represents that they thoroughly and completely understand that this is a complete and final release and indemnity agreement, that they are freely and voluntarily entering into this Agreement, and that no representations, promises or statements made by any of the Released Parties, or any agent, attorney or other representative of any of the Released Parties has influenced the undersigned in causing them to sign this Agreement.

10. **MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS:** The undersigned acknowledges receipt of all rules and guidelines that govern or apply to the Activities, and further acknowledges that they have reviewed and will abide by such rules and guidelines. The undersigned understands that this agreement shall be binding on their heirs, executors, successors and assigns, that the Agreement will be governed by the laws of Texas, and that jurisdiction and venue for resolution of any dispute regarding this Agreement shall lie in State District Courts in Travis County, Texas. If any part of this Agreement is determined to be invalid or unenforceable, it does not affect the validity of the remainder of this Agreement. The undersigned agrees to the terms and conditions above, and acknowledges receipt of this Agreement.
